• Grace Memorial B.C. is part of the North Lawndale Community, rich in history of helping others for over 60 years. The church while its home and focus is in the North Lawndale Community, has a membership of over 300, whose families reside in all parts of the city and support a weekly food pantry and supportive services by providing for an average of 500 families per month. We also provide recycling of bio-fuels, neighborhood clean & green, Summer Safe Haven, the Grace at Jerusalem Family Community Roots Festival, Basic Skills Training & Security Training & Referral Program.
